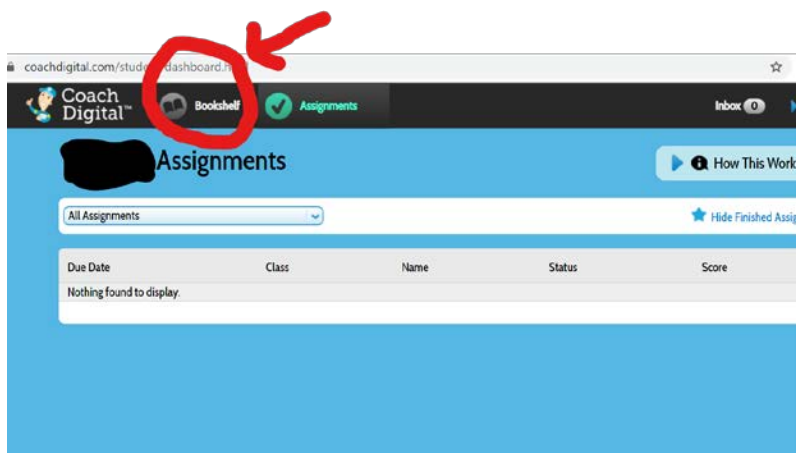

Teachers can load specific assignments to students, as well as parents/students may search the multitude of resources as well.

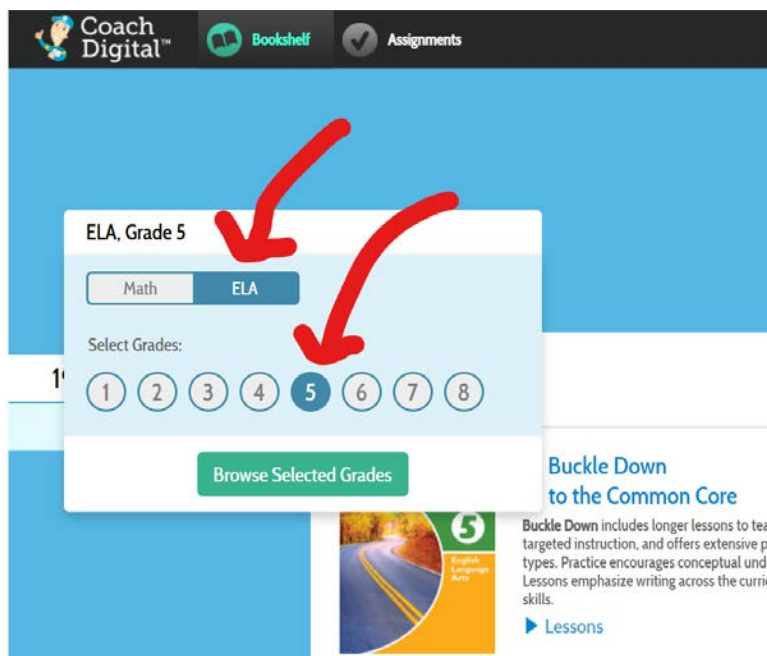
To search for lessons, practice, and resources click the "Bookshelf" link in the top left-hand corner. You can browse subject area and grade to find practice.

Coach Digital—finding extra lessons

1. From your child's homepage click the "Bookshelf" icon



2. Once on the bookshelf screen, choose the subject area and grade you wish to search.



3. A list of possible books with extra resources will pop up. Some are PDFs and some are online activities.
