**School GeoBee:** February 5<sup>th</sup> we will hold the Dolvin GeoBee at 8:00 am in the commons.

About the School GeoBee: The top ten school qualifiers (based on written test results) will participate in the GeoBee. The School-Level GeoBee is a combination of oral question rounds and written question rounds. The School Champion will be determined by this competition.

Next Steps: The School Champion takes a proctored online qualifying test in school on February 6<sup>th</sup>. The top-100-ranked students in each state will be invited to represent their school at the State GeoBee on March 27, 2020!
